

Report of the Event

The session 1 of the day 1 begun with inaugural address by the esteemed coordinator of the IQAC Dr. Renu. The first session of the two-day Webinar was addressed by Chairman of the collaborating organization Shri Devender Singh ji, Shiksha Sanskriti Utthan Nyas. Shri Devender ji highlighted the need of revised curriculum in higher education to incorporate elements of indigenous knowledge base to explore the solution-oriented syllabus and to bring the faculty fraternity on a common platform to meet the common goal of education.

Followed by the inaugural address, esteemed principal, and the chairperson of the IQAC – Prof. Kalpana Bhakuni welcomed the audience in the two-day national webinar. Prof. Bhakuni presented a brief idea about the documented policies of the National Education Policy 2021 directed towards transformation of the education system keeping the importance of demographic profile and aspirations of the young population in educational policies.

The first session By Prof. Dr. Padmavathi B S, Head, Centre for Educational and Social Studies, an awardee of prestigious awards from international bodies and contributor in the state education policies, NGOs in the educational domain and rich academic resources. Prof Padmavati urged the need to revisit the course curricula of higher education to suit the pursuits of emerging higher educational needs through bringing the stakeholders' thought processes on common platform to redesign the policy. She focussed on implementation part of the proposed policy by introducing the roles of UGC RUSA, NPIU, TEQIP as part of strategic Institutional Development Plans (IDP), components to be included in IDP of the Higher Educational Institutions (HEI) within the framework of NEP recommendations. Some of the important components emphasised were curriculum improvement, funding of topic cantered clubs and activities organized by students, initiatives of Academic Bank Credit and Teachers capacity Building (FDP's) etc and making the same accessible and equitable. The wholistic presentation further covered the strategic steps and guidelines towards implementing the NEP recommendations in HEIs.


The first Session ended with an announcement to follow-up the second session of the first day

In the second session of the first day of the webinar, Prof , Dayashankar Tiwary, delivered a talk on the topic "Rastriya Siksha Niti 2020 mai Sanskrit ki Bhumika" (Role of Sanskrit in the National Education Policy 2020). Dr. Tiwary emphasized on the role of multilingual pedagogy in the education system including the regional languages. Sanskrit being the third most important language shall be made multidisciplinary to establish it as professional course and further as a medium to connect Vedic knowledge with the tenets of the core science and social science disciplines including the purse sciences such as engineering and mathematics. The provision

of financial assistance to the discipline is required for development of the larger targets. Dr Tiwary urged for a larger endeavour towards translation of the Vedic knowledge for which Institutions shall establish specialized centres. He also pointed out the provision of financial assistance towards meeting the goal of making the discipline not just as a language but also as a capability to be suitable for the professional and career pursuits.

The participants raised several queries during the question-and-answer session such as focussing the measures to be taken towards connecting the Higher education with Secondary and Senior secondary school education.

The session ended with endorsing remarks and need to develop adequate infrastructure and technology in HEI for promotion of Sanskrit as a professional program by Prof. Kalpana Bhakuni. The session ended with vote of thanks by the IQAC coordinator.

- The IICD Director Dr. Toolika Gupta, Steering Committee members of IQAC including Coordinator Dr. Barun Shankar Gupta welcomed Kamala Nehru College Principal Dr.Kalpana Bhakuni, Principal, Kamala Nehru College, and IQAC Core Members Ms.Vinita Malik and Ms. Harpreet Kaur Arora and addressed the morning session.
- Dr. Toolika Gupta, along with the steering committee updated progress pertaining to their work towards NAAC with regards to IIQA and SSR (Cycle 1). The Paramarsh team also was familiarized with the College and the journey so far since its inception in 1995. The Indian Institute of Crafts & Design, Jaipur, was set up as an autonomous institute by the Government of Rajasthan in the year 1995 to act as a catalyst of change in the craft sector. IICD provides Bachelor and Master degree in various areas of Crafts & design.
- It was informed that IICD envisions to invigorate the craft sector and to become the Centre of Excellence in Crafts & Design, encouraging research and bringing new life to the languishing crafts of India.
- Dr. Bhakuni wanted that the institute should be first seen so that we are left with enough time for discussion and question/answer session.
- The KNC team was taken around the college and were shown the infrastructure of the institute. The craft workshops, hostel, faculty room etc. were visited and it was informed that hands on training was given to the students.
- Dr. Bhakuni suggested that appropriate signages to be put up in the building.
- In the evening the IQAC members of IICD were addressed by Dr. Kalpana Bhakuni. She gave a road map of the NAAC procedure including IIQA and the SSR.
- She recommended to take up registration under AISHE and other technical aspects related to NAAC before filling up the SSR.
- Dr. Bhakuni highlighted on the relevance of new initiatives to be undertaken such as research grants to be acquired and publications of the faculty to be encouraged, extension and outreach programs as essential activities, the need for Green Audit, Academic and Administrative Audit, in-house journal with ISSN number (preferably UGC-Care listed), Incubation Cell, E-Governance and other such initiatives.

- It was also advised to take up initiatives on waste-management, E-waste and water harvesting.
- They were suggested to provide support to the students during the Covid period either through data card for online classes.
- The IQAC Core member Ms. Vinita Malik suggested the significance of identifying the weak areas as a way ahead to achieve the goals.
- Dr. Barun Shankar Gupta, Coordinator IQAC, IICD (Convener NAAC Steering Committee) presented a progress report regarding NAAC for the benefit of the Paramarsh team and the other members present so that they could be further assessed and guided in preparation for NAAC.
- Questions were raised to the Mentor College (KNC) visiting team for the benefit of the Mentee institute (IICD) for NAAC and SSR Preparation.
- Query was raised by the IICD team as how to showcase the Publications during the Peer Team Visit.
- To initiate the process Dr. Bhakuni suggested to create Criterion Heads and then the extended team to collate the data. Ms. Harpreet further added that the google sheets and forms to be circulated to collect data.
- Question was raised in context of the documentation of the financial data by the Mentee college. It was suggested to collate the information of the assessment period and should also be showcased at the time of Peer Team Visit if asked for.
- Discussions were done even pertaining to Alumni contributions and participation.
- A very interactive session was held between the members of IICD and the KNC visiting team where various queries and concerns were raised pertaining to NAAC- all of which were answered in detail by Director/Principal and the Paramarsh team.
- The interactive session ended with a vote of thanks by the IQAC Coordinator IICD.

Workshop on 'Revised Accreditation Framework: Highlights of NAAC' Organized by IQAC 2nd May 2019, 11am to 5pm

Internal Quality Assurance Cell of Kamala Nehru College, University of Delhi organized a workshop on 'Revised Accreditation Framework: Highlights of NAAC' on 2nd May 2019, 11am to 5pm for a detailed understanding of new guidelines for the preparation for the second cycle of accreditation of college by NAAC which is due in 2021-22. All the members of IQAC, Teacher-In charges of the Departments, Conveners of Committees and Societies of College, AQAR representatives of each Department as well as the Section Heads of the Administrative staff attended the workshop. The purpose of arranging the workshop was to get the whole college together towards the first step for the preparation of the second cycle of accreditation.


