






## Day 1 - Inaugural Session - Live









Day 3- separate sessions were organized in two parts.




Day 5 – had been observed as national holiday on occasion of Republic Day. The participants were required to fill the details and provide feedback on the sessions on previous days.



### Day 6, Sessions had been organized in three separate parts.




## Day 7: Sessions were organized in two parts
