Report 2012-13

On the foundation day of Election Commission of India, district election office celebrated National Voter's Day at Dipsar auditorium on 25th January 2012. Three students of our college had participated in the debate competition organized by Election Commission of India and won 2nd, 3rd and one consolation prize. "Politik", the annual festival of the department was held on 28 th February 2012. The activities included Nukkad Natak, debate on 'Smaller States are better for Indian Democracy', a talk by Mr. Prabhu Chawla on 'State Politics in India', Rangoli making, book mark making competitions.

A talk by Dr. Bhattacharya on 'Democracy and Development' was organized for first year and second year students on 15th March 2012. With the commencement of new academic session, an orientation programme was held for the first year students on July 24, 2012. On 22nd September 2012 ten students from 3rd semester (English medium) went to the American centre to participate in a lecture cum discussion on "Citizens' Participation in Democracy."
