ELIGIBILITY

All current students of Kamala Nehru College, Delhi, India

Evaluation Factors:

- **1.** A Five member jury will assess the nature of work/act(s) done in the 9-10 month period prior to submission of the report. The report must be submitted to the Principal's office, KNC latest by February 28, 2025, 2 p.m. and must include:
 - Description of applicant.
 - Detailed description of the work/act(s) which has/have significant impact or brings meaningful change in the lives of KNC students, faculty or staff or others in the National Capital Region of Delhi.
- **2.** The work/act(s) must be capable of objective verification by the jury.
- **3.** Important considerations for Evaluation:

Extent of sustained personal involvement.

Long term significance or impact on the lives of others (and how this is demonstrated).

Evidence of any first time Initiative, Uniqueness or Significant Courage, Compassion or Leadership. Ability to replicate work/act(s).

- **4.** All things being equal, attendance (minimum 67% in the relevant year); academic results (minimum 7.36 CGPA in the relevant year); and past community or other track record (in the immediately preceding 1 year while being a student of KNC) will also be considered.
- **5.** The Jury will select one or maximum two winner(s) based on the work/act(s) having significant impact (as described in the report + interview + physical visit, if required). The 2025 Jury will comprise of 5 persons: 2 Professors from KNC; Ms. Lira Goswami & 2 other persons (nominated by Ms. Lira Goswami). Jury composition may change in subsequent years.
- **6.** The total monetary award is upto Rs. 1,00,000. Winner(s) of the relevant year cannot apply for the Award in the following year.
