L'Esprit, the Psychology Association of Kamala Nehru College is a very active association, organizing various seminars and activities for its students. The academic year 2010-11 started with an informal orientation program for the freshers. This was followed by screening of "A Beautiful Mind" to educate the students about schizophrenia and increase its awareness.

Every year the department organizes some certificate course to add value to the degree in psychology. This year the students were offered a course in 'Cognitive Behaviour Therapy' . It was conducted by mental health professionals i.e. psychologists and psychiatrists , from Department of Mental Health and Behavioral Sciences, Max Healthcare under the guidance of Dr. Samir Parikh (Chief Consultant Psychiatrist).
