Report 2015

The National Seminar on 'Fundamentalism: Identities Unveiled' was organized by the Department of Psychology on 10th March 2015. The distinguished speakers for the event were Dr. Sudhir Kakar (Psychoanalyst and renowned writer), Prof. T. K. Oommen (Sociologist), Prof. Ashok Nagpal (School of Human Studies, Ambedkar University),

and Prof. Gurpreet Mahajan (Centre for Political Studies, Jawaharlal Nehru University).

The department had a formal orientation for the first-year students on 17th July 2015. The department conducted student body elections for L'ESPIRIT-(Psychology Association) on 14 August 2015. Ice Breaking Session based on the theme 'Mismatched' was organized for first-year students on 20th August 2015.
