

Election Code of Conduct

NOMINATION RULES:

1. The candidate must have secured 55% and above in the previous semester examination.
2. She must be a regular student of the college for one year.
3. The name of the candidate must be proposed and seconded by students.
4. The candidate should not be short of the attendance. For students of 2nd year and 3rd year, a minimum attendance of 66% in the previous semester is mandatory.
5. Candidate who has participated in extra-curricular activities will be given preference.
6. Students against whom disciplinary action has been taken in the past shall not be eligible to contest.
7. The candidate must obtain a NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE (NOC) from parent/guardian and teacher-in-charge of the respective department and attach it with her nomination form.
8. The candidate must give a written undertaking that she would abide by the election code of conduct and would not participate or conduct any activity which brings disrepute to the College. Doing so will result in the removal of the candidate from the post.
9. Indulging in any activity which violates 'the election code of conduct' during campaigning will result in disqualification.
10. The College authorities reserve the right to cancel the nomination of any candidate who does not meet the criteria.

CAMPAIGNING RULES:

1. For campaigning, candidates will prepare a poster and a short video clip with their photo highlighting their agenda, only after receiving due approval from the Student Council Advisors.
2. Candidates should not resort to any inappropriate means to seek votes. Votes sought on the basis of caste, community, religion and other such factors are extremely regressive and therefore condemned and discouraged.
3. Any kind of violence or disruption of the college decorum during campaigning by any candidate will result in disqualification of the candidate.
4. Participation in the election debate is mandatory. Any candidate not doing so must produce a valid explanation. Failing to do so will result in disqualification. Each candidate will be allotted 5 minutes to speak. The candidate will be expected to take questions from the audience but no cross questioning will be allowed.
5. The candidate who does not qualify the interview will not be eligible for contesting. The decision of the panel will be final.
6. Violating the above rules will result in disqualification.

VOTING RULES:

1. A Google form link will be circulated department-wise. The students should choose one option against their preferred candidate.
2. All students must upload a photo of their Identity Cards or Admission receipts on the Google form on the day of the election, failing to do so will make your vote invalid.

COUNTING RULES:

1. The counting will be done by teachers and office staff.
2. List of the Invalid votes to be kept in separate folders.
3. Students are allowed to check the counted votes only on the day of the election and in the presence of the teachers.
4. If a candidate wins by even one vote, she will be declared as elected.
5. In case of a tie, election will be held again for that post.

RULES GOVERNING ELECTED REPRESENTATIVES:

1. The elected candidates shall not be allowed to hold two offices at the same time.
2. The elected representative must work in good spirit with the intention of serving the students community at large.
3. They should not use their position for the personal gains.
4. Strict action will be taken against any member indulging in any financial irregularity.
5. They must not indulge which brings disrepute to the College.
6. Any undesirable action taken by even one member will amount to collective responsibility and result in disqualification of the whole team. Members are expected to keep a check on any undesirable activity indulged by any member and report such matter to the College authorities.
7. The team must exhibit exemplary leadership and set an example for the student community.
